Mobile Pick & Carry Crane - Checklist

Always plan the job no matter how small – If you can't get the time to plan the job don't do it

Consider the following.

- Risk Assessment completed and task specific SWMS in place.
- The crane is fit for purpose and capable of doing the job.
- Crane crew all qualified and competent
- Personal - psychological state, stress, fatigue, just not feeling well (all affect performance)
- All relevant documentation provided to crane crew.
- Is the crane in good condition, tyres correctly inflated, been maintained and serviced?
- The lifting gear chains, hooks, slings, rings, tag lines, packing etc. all available and in good condition and tagged.
- Consider the weight, size, shape, and composition of all loads.
- Has the travel route been assessed for condition, obstacles and obstructions?
- Interface with other plant, vehicles and pedestrians has been considered.
- Exclusion zones and signage established during travel and at loading, unloading points and spotters assigned.
- Ground conditions particularly when articulating the crane - underground and overhead services, uneven ground, sloping ground, soft ground, slippery surfaces.
- Operating within structure – Contact with structure.
- Weather conditions – Lightning, rain, wind, and extreme heat
- Is an emergency response plan in place?

We all have a duty of care to ourselves and our workmates.

This is by no means everything that needs to be considered and different situations present varying hazards, don't be complacent, the consequences may be catastrophic.
