Evacuation			
Is there an evacuation procedure to be followed in the event of a fire or other type of emergency?			
Is the evacuation procedure and a diagram of the workplace (showing the exits & muster points) displayed in a prominent location?			
Is the evacuation procedure practiced at reasonable intervals, where practicable?			
Is the workplace arranged so that people can safely move within it? Are the passages for movement always kept free of obstructions and adequately lit?			
Does the emergency egress enable safe egress in event of an emergency? This includes ensuring that doors are free of obstructions.			
Have compliant exit signs been provided and are they maintained?			
Have portable fire extinguishers been provided, located and distributed in accordance with Australian Standard AS/NZS 2444?			
Are portable fire extinguishers regularly maintained?			
Is a fire blanket available where applicable?			
Is training provided on how to use fire extinguishers and other safety equipment to people who will be required to help control or extinguish a fire?			
Are trained personnel and dedicated equipment available on site for identified emergencies such as confined space or working at height rescues?			
Are trained first aiders and emergency responders identified and known to all site personnel?			
Are there procedures in place for isolated workers? They must have a means of communication available to call for help and procedures for regular contact that they have been trained in.			
First aid			
Have an adequate number of people been trained in first aid, having regard to the types of hazards and number of people at the workplace?			
Is an adequately stocked first aid kit provided at a central location?			
Is the first aid kit regularly inspected to ensure adequate supplies are present?			
Are other first aid facilities provided and maintained if indicated by the hazards at the workplace? For example, provision of a safety shower and eyewash where corrosive liquids are handled.			
Is there a system for recording site injuries and first aid treatments?
